



LESOTHO COLLEGE OF EDUCATION BRIDGING PROGRAMME FOR 2023

1.1 This bridging Programme is intended for prospective students who do not meet the LCE minimum entry requirements for Diploma programmes. Requirements for the bridging programme are as follows: LGSCE and/or other post-secondary qualifications:

- 1.1.1 2 credits (symbol C or better) and 3 passes (symbols D and/or E) including English, or
- 1.1.2 1 credit (symbol C or better) and three Ds and English (at minimum E) as one of the subjects.
- 1.1.3 3 credits (symbol C or better) and at least an F in English

1.2 Students in the Bridging programme will enroll in the courses that would enable them to meet the entry requirements and place them at par with their straight Diploma entrants' counterparts. That is:

- 1.2.1 Students falling under criteria 1.1.1 would take up **one** subject in the bridging programme
- 1.2.2 Students falling under criteria 1.1.2 would take **two** subjects in the bridging programme
- 1.2.3 Students falling criteria 1.1.3 would take up to **two** subjects in the bridging programme including English

1.3 The subjects offered in the programme are:

- 1.3.1 English (which will also address communication and study skills)
- 1.3.2 Mathematics for prospective DEP and non-Mathematics majors,
- 1.3.3 Sesotho for prospective DEP students
- 1.3.4 Science for prospective DEP and non-Science specialisations
- 1.3.5 Mathematics for prospective DES majoring in Mathematics
- 1.3.6 Science for prospective DES students majoring in Science
- 1.3.7 Accounting Prospective Diploma in Education (Secondary)

2.0 Fees to be paid

2.1 The following Fees shall be paid by the students enrolled in the bridging programme:

- M 750.00 for one course
- M 1400.00 for two courses
- M 2000.00 for three courses

2.2 The fees are inclusive of all fees except boarding and lodging which will be charged at standard rates.

2.3 Duration of the programme

The duration of the bridging program shall be two months commencing from March to May 2023. Application forms will be obtained from LCE website and Facebook page from 22nd February to 31st March 2023.
