



## BRIDGING PROGRAMME FOR 2023

This bridging Programme is intended for prospective students who do not meet the LCE entry requirements for Diploma programmes, but have performed in the following manner in their LGSCE and/or other post-secondary qualifications:

- 2 credits (symbol C or better) and 3 passes (symbols D and/or E) including English, or
- 1 credit (symbol C or better) and three Ds and English (at minimum E) as one of the subjects.
- 3 credits (symbol C or better) and at least an F in English

The courses offered in the programme will be such that the students take up courses that would enable them to meet the entry requirements and put them at par with their straight Diploma entrants' counterparts. That is:

### Students fitting criteria

1.1.1 would take up one subject in the bridging programme.

### Students fitting criteria

1.1.2 would take two subjects in the bridging programme

### Students fitting criteria

1.1.3 would take at most two subjects in the bridging programme including English

### The subjects offered in the programme will include:

- English (which will also address communication and study skills)
- Mathematics for prospective DEP and non-Mathematics majors,
- Sesotho for prospective DEP students
- Science for prospective DEP and non-Science specialisations
- Mathematics for prospective DES majoring in Mathematics
- Science for prospective DES students majoring in Science
- Accounting Prospective Diploma in Education (Secondary)

## FEES TO BE PAID

The following Fees shall be paid by the students enrolled in the bridging programme:

- M 750.00 for one course
- M 1400.00 for two courses
- M 2000.00 for three courses

The fees are inclusive of all fees except boarding and lodging which will be charged at standard rates.

The duration of the bridging program shall be two months commencing from March to May 2023. Application forms will be obtained from LCE website and Facebook page from 17th February to 31st March 2023.
